There are certain issues, that we feel, should be taken up at home and in school seriously so that we are able to inculcate good values amongst our children. These are :--

- Use of mobile phones
- Unrestricted and unsupervised use of Internet
- Use of foul and abusive language

- Distribution of any kind of invitation cards in the school
- Bringing money to school
- Use of self driven motorized vehicles
- Improper, shabby uniform and fancy haircuts & hair colors.
  Wearing fancy and heavy jewellery, friendship bands
- Coming late to school
- Taking leave without prior and proper information
- Bringing and exchanging slam books, film/music CD's/pen drives etc.

- No oral medicine to be carried/sent to the school
- No Tiffin or water bottle accepted after the child has reached the school
- Not to get involved in any kind of unacceptable behaviour in the school bus
- Students should bring only Cadbury Eclairs (A MAX OF 4 PIECES PER CHILD) or a maximum of 10 -15 Dairy Milk @Rs.10 for class distribution & celebrations on Birthday.) WE WOULD BE EXTREMELY HAPPY IF YOU DONATE A PLANT ON YOUR CHILD'S BIRTHDAY TO BE PLANTED IN SCHOOL. Extra items bought to school will be confiscated by the discipline committee and further not be returned to the student.
- Boys & Girls must have very short hair, and/or for girls hair should be neatly plaited for hair longer than shoulder length and a black hair band is a must for girls with short hair

At school, we are going to be very strict and particular about these matters and we wish to seek your co-operation and support so that we are able to enforce these successfully.

We request you to please do not call teachers on their mobiles during school hours. Ideally, you are requested to contact the school front desk for any concern of yours. We will certainly get back to you within 24 hours or even much sooner depending on the urgency of the matter.

Monthly Academic Plans, Formative Assessment & Summative Assessment / (Units) Syllabus will be posted on website /mail regularly. You are requested to make the best use of it and get back to us as and when required. In order to avail the SMS Alert facility, you are requested to register a permanent mobile number with the class teacher and in case of any change, please inform the class teacher immediately. (Please refer to highlights too)
