General rules and regulations

Parents can also make "ON SPOT" registrations. (Verbal registration over the phone will be accepted. The registration fee can be paid once the participant reaches the venue on the day of the event)

{Group A1– LKG, A2 – UKG } & {Group B1– Grade 1 , B2– Grade 2}

- Each participant should carry identity proof. (School ID Card or any other ID Proof)
- Medium of Language : English only
- Contestants must be at the venue at least 15 minutes before the competition starts.
- Participants and parents should go through the event rules and strictly adhere to them.
- A participant can participate only in one event during the simultaneous timings for events; a participant is not restricted to participation in any number of events as long as the event timings do not clash.
- All the events will commence at the scheduled time; Punctuality will be appreciated.
- Rules are subject to changes at the discretion of the Management/Organizers.
- If a student wants to withdraw his/her entry after submission or change his submission he will have to send the request to info@lakshyaschool.in by 29th Feb, 2020.
- Before the winners are announced, they will be contacted to verify their identity as filled in the registration form.
- 3 Winners per category will be identified by the judges and rewarded.
- The judges' decision will be final.

Rhymes competition (Nursery to Grade - II)

- Theme : Choice of the Participant
- Each contestant will recite one (1) Rhyme and in English only. Each contestant will be given a maximum of 3 minutes.
- Setting up props, stage set up time will be separate.
- Please note that props usage will be given 5 points. Ideally props can be home made instead of expensive stuff being used for props.
- Parents are also requested not to spend money on expensive costumes. It can be creatively made at home.
- The Rhyme should be preceded by a 2-3 line self introduction.

Rubrics for Judgment: 1) Expressions 2) Clarity 3) Voice and Articulation 4) Overall performance and 5) Innovative Props.



Story telling (Nursery to Grade - II)

- Theme : Choice of the participant
- The contestant may bring their own props needed to tell the story.
- Parents may set up the props on stage before the program begins.
- The participants shall deliver the stories not more than 4 minutes.
- The participants may stand up and move or sit in the chair while delivering their story.
- Background music is allowed. If back ground music is used for story telling the music file should be given to our IT official (in campus) well before time. IT official will be present at the venue on the day of the event. Reading the story from any paper / book is not permitted.
- Upon being introduced, the contestant shall proceed immediately to the speaking position. Timing will begin with the contestant's first definite verbal or nonverbal communication with the audience. This usually will be the first word uttered by the contestant
- Timer shall provide warning signals to the contestants, which shall be clearly visible to the speakers. Green light appears 15 secs before the ending time of the story. Red light will be the signal to stop.

Rubrics for Judgment: 1) Fluency 2) Expressions 3) Usage of Props 4) Creativity 5) Time management and Overall performance .

Painting (Nursery to Grade - II)

- Theme : **KG** – Me & My Family, **G 1 & 2** – Save water or Clean India.
- Painting can be done with (Poster colors, Tempera, Crayons and Colour pencils etc).
- Winners per category will be identified by the judges and rewarded.
- Students must carry a A4 size painting board / Exam Board to the venue.
- Painting sheet will be provided by the organization and the timing is 1 ½ hr.

Rubrics for Judgment: 1) Idea 2) Creativity 3) Picture composition 4) Colouring quality 5) Time Management.



Fancy Dress (Nursery to Grade - II)



- (Theme for - **LKG & UKG** : Nature) and (Theme for – **G 1 & 2** : Fruits or Flowers or Animals)
- Participants can choose desired costumes or characters. Parents can design the dress at home too. Home made innovative costumes will be appreciated and valued.
- Each participant should deliver a short narration on his or her character.
- Maximum time on stage including narration 2 mins
- Participants need to introduce themselves, walk the ramp and speak about the character being showcased.
- Participants will be judged according to character portrayed, creativity and presentation skills.

Rubrics for Judgment: 1) Costumes 2) Makeup 3) Theme Adherence 4) Speaking 5) Overall Presentation
